Summary:

The National DigiFoundry (NDF) held a kickoff meeting to introduce the program and its goals. The NDF is a partnership funded by the National Science Foundation (NSF) and led by the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA) and Forward Edge-AI (FEAI). The program aims to explore global standards and best practices for the use and exchange of digital assets. The meeting covered various topics, including the program's agenda, infrastructure, working groups, and operational cadence. The NDF has three initial working groups focused on: 1) climate change related disaster response, 2) healthcare research publishing, and 3) secure information sharing. The program plans to hold quarterly meetings with the first annual meeting in January 2024 and aims to achieve full operational capability by December 2024. The meeting also discussed the use of tokens for funding and governance within the NDF, as well as the potential involvement of government agencies and the private sector.
